


THE CHURCH AT LITCHFIELD PARK A HOUSE OF PRAYER FOR ALL PEOPLE

The season of Lent is a time for us to strengthen our faith in Christ as we intentionally fast, pray, worship, study, serve and give.

We encourage everyone to participate in **Lenten Table Talk** by picking up a jar from the Sanctuary. In the jar you will find a candle and booklet with weekly reflections on Scripture and our mission partners. During your devotional time, consider placing an offering into the jar, which will be collected on Easter Sunday to bless those we support. Share your journey by posting photos on social media using #CLP.

Lent begins with **Ash Wednesday**; our service on March 5 is at 6:30 pm. Sunday worship during Lent continues at 8:30 & 10 am. Our dinner church, **The Table@CLP**, gathers each Wednesday at 5:15 pm. Each Tuesday, from 11:30 - 12:30, our sanctuary is open for **Ignite!** prayer, with communion available starting at 12 noon.

We anticipate a very special **Easter Egg Hunt** this year as CLP partners with The City of Litchfield Park. On **Palm Sunday**, April 13, come and celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry and our confirmation students' faith commitments at 8:30 and 10 am.

Join us for **Maundy Thursday** communion on April 17 at 6:30 pm, a reflective **Good Friday** Tenebrae service on April 18, also at 6:30 pm.

Easter Sunday at CLP dawns with a 6:00 am sunrise service. Our resurrection celebration continues with worship in the sanctuary at both 8:30 and 10 am. The Lord is risen; He is risen indeed!
